Gunnersbury Park – Phase 3 – Upcoming Sports Public Meetings:

- **Thursday 23rd July 2015 7pm, Terrace Room, Small Mansion, Gunnersbury Park**

A major new Sports Hub for Gunnersbury is currently under development, which marks the next phase in the regeneration of Gunnersbury Park. This large-scale project aims to unlock the enormous untapped potential of the site to achieve a transformational change, making Gunnersbury Park a 'destination' for visitors across London. Working closely with the Heritage Lottery Fund and English Heritage, the first £21m phase of investment for the museum and areas of the park will be starting on site in 2015.

A Project Team led by the London Borough of Ealing & Hounslow Councils are embarking on the final phase of this exciting project and are inviting you to come along to the above public meeting, to hear further about progress made and ongoing plans to develop sports facilities.

We feel it's important to give all residents a platform for feedback, but are aware July is a busy time of year for some, and have therefore also organised a second public consultation event, which will take place on **Tuesday 8th September 2015, also commencing at 7pm in Gunnersbury Park's Small Mansion Terrace Room.**

As with the previous consultation event, which took place in late March 2015, representatives from both Ealing & Hounslow Councils and AFLS+P, Architects responsible for leading on the design of the building, will be on hand at each of the events to answer any questions.
